
PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN

Two swimming pools, little league and regulation hardball diamonds, play equipment, group picnic area, two basketball courts (1/2 courts), horseshoe pits, restrooms, home of the Lodi Boys and Girls Club. (10.0 acres)

(Holly Drive & Lake Street)

Tot lot play equipment, picnic area. (0.2 acres)
