AGENDA TITLE: Bid Award for White Slough Water Pollution Control Facility Replacement of Fiberglass Effluent Troughs (\$18,000)

MEETING DATE: June 3, 1998

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the bid for the above project to Warminster Fiberglass Company in the amount of \$17,994.25 and appropriate funds in accordance with the recommendation shown below.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of replacing the four 30+-year-old effluent troughs for primary sedimentation basins #1 and #2. The White Slough Facility presently operates five primary sedimentation basins. The three newer basins, built in 1975 and 1989, are equipped with fiberglass troughs and the two older basins, built in 1967, have steel troughs. Installation will be performed by facility operations and maintenance staff. This project is included in the current Capital Improvement Budget as "White Slough Primary Sedimentation Tanks."

Specifications for this project were approved on May 6, 1998. Copies of specifications were mailed to four prospective bidders. The City received the following bid for this project:
