
RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council set a Public Hearing for November 18, 1998 to consider the technical equipment purchase proposal for the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On July 10, 1998, the Lodi Police Department applied for a Grant from the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program Funds in the amount of \$93,372, which includes matching funds of \$9,372. The source of the matching funds will be taken from the 1998/1999 Lodi Police Department Budget. When the funds are received, they will be placed in a special revenue fund, pending dispersal. The Police Department plans to purchase software for the Records Management System.


FUNDING: Total Grant is \$93,720, including matching City Funds in the amount of \$9,372.
