


BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Lodi's Transit Division is in the process of preparing the Program of Projects for fiscal year 1998/99 to be submitted to the FTA. Part of that process is to hold a public hearing. The Program of Projects for fiscal year 1998/99 likely will contain more FTA funds for the Multimodal Station so that construction can be completed. Listed below are the projects requested to be included in this Program and the dollar amount of each.


NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
