AGENDA TITLE: Purchase of High Pressure Sodium Luminaires (\$15,131.60)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the bid for the purchase of 175 high-pressure sodium luminaires to the low bidder, GE Supply Company of Sacramento in the amount of \$15,131.60.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On March 20, 1996, the City Council authorized advertisement for bids for luminaires for the Electric Utility Department's program of replacing mercury vapor lights with the more efficient high pressure sodium luminaires.

The following bids were received, and opened on April 3, 1996:

Some of the locations where replacement lights will be installed are the 100 and 200 blocks of West Lockeford Street, Elm Street west of Garden Drive, Beckman Road and Cluff Avenue north of Lockeford Street, Turner Road east of Beckman, Hansen Drive and the 600 and 700 blocks of West Lodi Avenue, and various locations along Ham Lane between Elm Street and Kettleman Lane. (Eleven of the lights purchased will be placed in inventory).

Delivery of luminaires is expected in about three weeks.
