RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the purchase of thirteen reclining chairs to the low bidder, California Office Furniture of Sacramento, in the amount of \$6,023.23.


BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On March 20, 1996, the City Council approved revised specifications and authorized advertisement for bids for thirteen commercial-grade reclining chairs for use in the day rooms at the City's three fire stations.

Bid forms were sent to nine office furniture dealers; however, only two responded. Bids were opened on May 7, 1996:

The furniture in the fire station day rooms is approximately seven years old. This furniture is subject to heavy use and is worn beyond repair. The purchase of these thirteen recliners would provide fire safety personnel who are confined to 24-hour shifts adequate furniture for their rest and relaxation. These chairs have been selected by the department for both comfort and the commercial-grade warranty on mechanical parts, frame, and springs.


