RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Popuch Concrete Contracting, of Lodi, in the amount of \$48,275, and appropriate funds in accordance with the recommendation shown below.


BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project will retrofit handicap ramps at eight curb returns and five alley approaches along with other incidental and related work. The eight curb return locations are: the intersection of Pine Street and Lee Street; the northeast and northwest corners of Lodi Avenue and Church Street; and the northeast and northwest corners of Walnut Street and Pleasant Avenue.

The alley approaches receiving new ramps are on Church Street. The alley south of Oak Street will be retrofitted with four new ramps and the alley south of Pine Street will be receiving a new ramp on its north corner.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on May 15, 1996. The City received the following two bids for this project:
