
BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of the abandonment and destruction of eight privately-constructed agricultural wells now owned by the City of Lodi. These wells are located on the East Lodi Avenue property acquired by the City as part of the economic development plans for Guild Avenue. These wells must be destroyed prior to the development of the parcels.


These wells vary in depth from 50 feet to 300 feet and were primarily used for flood irrigation. Some of the wells have not been used in years. The oldest well dates from the 1930's. These wells are of no economic value to the City, hinder the development of the property, and legally must be destroyed.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on June 16, 1999. The City received the following three bids for this project:

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
