RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to the sole bidder, Sherman Supersonic Industries Corp., of Mississauga, Ontario, in the amount of \$122,060; and authorize the City Manager to execute a design contract to construct the washbay in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.

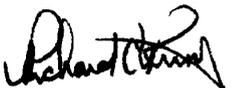
BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project is to purchase and install a washbay equipment system primarily for the bus fleet. The washbay will reduce labor costs for the entire Department and ensure a clean fleet of vehicles and equipment. This portion is for the equipment only. The City of Lodi needs to design the foundation and structure for the washbay along with drainage and other site improvements. The City is working with the Lodi Unified School District on the installation at their site at 820 South Cluff Avenue. This project has been reviewed with the 2x2 Committee. A joint-use agreement is being developed and LUSD will participate in the cost of the project.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on April 5, 2000.

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO FURNISH AND INSTALL WASHBAY SYSTEM, AND AUTHORIZE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A DESIGN CONTRACT

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on June 8, 2000, at 2:00 p.m. to Furnish and Install Washbay System, described in the specifications, therefore approved by the City Council on April 5, 2000; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends award of the contract to Furnish and Install Washbay System to the low bidder, Sherman Supersonic Industries Corp., of Mississauga, Ontario in the amount of \$122,060, and further recommends executing a design contract to construct the washbay in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lodi City Council that the award of the bid to Furnish and Install Washbay System be and the same is hereby awarded to the low bidder, Windwalker Security Patrol of Thornton, California; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Lodi City Council that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a design contract to construct the washbay in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.
