AGENDA TITLE: Award Contract for Polymer Modified Chip Seal for Various City Streets, 2000 (\$125,530)

MEETING DATE: August 29, 2000

PREPARED BY: Public Works Director

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Telfer Oil Company DBA Windsor Fuel Company, of Windsor, in the amount of \$125,530.90; and appropriate funds as recommended below.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of applying polymer modified chip seal to 100,345 square yards of various City streets (see attached list), and other incidental and related work as outlined in the specifications.

Unfortunately, the bid price is considerably higher than the project estimate. Contributing to this is recent increases in fuel prices, which affect the emulsion price and the costs for hauling aggregate to the job; the amount of sweeping required in the contract; and that we are late in the season and contractors are relatively busy. An alternative would be to wait until spring to rebid the project. However, there is some risk that prices may not go down and that the streets will deteriorate, thus requiring additional work and cost.

Specifications for this project were approved on August 2, 2000. The City received the following two bids:


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds be appropriated as follows:
