AGENDA TITLE: Award Contract for Loel Senior Center Bus Shelter and Street Improvements at the Corner of Oak and Washington Streets (\$122,850)

MEETING DATE: September 20, 2000

PREPARED BY: Public Works Director

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Diede Construction, of Woodbridge, in the amount of \$122,852; and appropriate funds in accordance with the recommendation shown below.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of tile-faced columns and sitting blocks straddling the sidewalk, a roof, windscreens, and two to four paintings. The project also includes sidewalk and parkway strip improvements along Washington Street. The work includes replacement of the four palm trees with cedar trees. This bus stop, at the corner of Washington and Oak streets, is the third busiest stop on the GrapeLine route.

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) encourages art in public places. The Lodi Arts Commission received proposals from three artists and chose M. Sheila Ghidini of San Francisco. Over the course of three sessions, members of the public made tiles and painted transportation-themed artworks.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on September 16, 1998. The City received the following three bids for this project:


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds be appropriated as follows:
