AGENDA TITLE: Contract Award for 1994/95 Handicap Ramp Retrofit Project, Various Locations (\$39,111)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Farwest Safety, Inc. of Tracy in the amount of \$39,111.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of retrofitting approximately twenty curb returns with handicap ramps, relocating three catch basins, and other incidental and related work. Ramp locations are based on the Council-approved handicap ramp priority list.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on December 21, 1994. The City received the following eight bids for this project:


