RECOMMENDED ACTION: 1.) That the Business Tax be waived, in part, for vendors who do not have a Business License and who will participate at the following event:

Women's Ministries of Century Assembly Craft Boutique to be held for one day on November 4, 1995 at 550 W. Century Blvd. This event is sponsored under the not-for-profit status of the Century Assembly, Inc. Documentation attached.

2.) That the fee be set at \$3.75 per vendor.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Ordinance 1607 Business Tax Certification, Section 3.01.030. Exemptions, paragraph H. Street Fairs and Special Events, permit sponsors of street fairs or special events to request the City Council waive the Business License Tax in part or whole for participants of a street fair or special event when the waiver is for a limited period of time and a participant does not otherwise conduct business within the City of Lodi.....; and, when the City Council determines a blanket waiver of the Business License Tax for a street fair or special event is in the best interest of the City.

The Business License tax for vendors of retail products is \$50.00.



2. That at a meeting of the Board of Directors of said corporation duly held at Lodi, California on June 3, 1973, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED: that Article 1 of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation be amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1

4. That the number of members who voted affirmatively for the adoption of said resolution is 94, and that the number of members constituting a quorum is 90





We the undersigned hereby associate ourselves to form a corporation for religious purpose under Title XII, Part IV, Division I, of the Civil Code of the State of California. And for purposes other than pecuniary profit. And we do hereby certify as follows.

Article 1.

The name of this corporation shall be Glad-Tidings- Evangelistic-Association of Lodi, California.

Article 2.

The purpose for which this corporation is formed are To teach and diffuse Moral, spiritual. And Religious Knowledge. To disseminate and propagate the Christian Religion, By means of Churches, Schools, and Publications. To further Religious Teachings, Preaching, Missions, Missionaries. And other religious Agencies, Methods, And Instrumentalities. And in furtherance of the foregoing powers and purposes to contract, convey, Take gift of real and personal property, sue and defend, Borrow money.
