AGENDA TITLE: Contract Award for Lodi Lake Nature Trail (\$14,300)

MEETING DATE: June 7, 1995

PREPARED BY: Public Works Director

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Don Lawley Company, Inc. in the amount of \$14,300.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This contract will furnish, spread and compact approximately 3,250 lineal feet of 8-foot wide decomposed granite path and other incidental and related work, all as shown on the plans and specifications for the project. The Street Division will grade and compact the subgrade on this nature trail.

A \$20,000 grant from the State Department of Parks and Recreation Habitat Conservation Fund Program will pay for most of this project with the Capital Outlay Reserve Fund covering the balance.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on March 15, 1995. The City received the following nine bids for this project:


