RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for ten portable communications radios for use by the Department's Partners volunteers.


BACKGROUND INFORMATION: At the present time we have 33 volunteers in our Police Partners Program. It is anticipated that within a year the program may have as many as 100 volunteers.

These radios are needed to provide the vital communications link between the volunteers and department officers and staff. As always in public safety, constant and reliable communication provides a crucial safety factor during the course of police business.

The equipment specified by the Department, the Motorola Portable P110, assures compatibility with Police communications equipment, and offers light-weight portability and ease of use.
