AGENDA TITLE: Contract Award for Holly Drive Storm Drain and Water Main, Ham Lane to 150 Feet East of Fairmont Avenue (\$82,552)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Robert Burns Construction of Stockton in the amount of \$82,552.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of installing approximately 800 linear feet of storm drain and 700 linear feet of water main, and other incidental and related work, all as shown on the plans and specifications for the project. These improvements are required to connect future water Well 25 to the City's distribution system. Well 25 is located in the Washington School play field on Holly Drive.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on June 1, 1994. The City received the following four bids for this project:


