AGENDA TITLE: Reject All Bids and Authorize Readvertisement for Bids for Pig's Lake Levee Repair

MEETING DATE: October 5, 1994

PREPARED BY: Public Works Director

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council reject all the bids for the Pig's Lake Levee Repair project and authorize readvertising for bids.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On September 21, 1994, the City received two bids for the Pig's Lake Levee Repair project. (The bid tabulation sheet is attached as Exhibit A.) Cimarron Construction was the apparent low bidder with a submittal of \$41,500.

During the review of Cimarron's bid proposal, it was discovered that the Contractor's License number, license classification, license expiration date, company name, address and phone number had not been provided on the last sheet of the proposal. The last sheet had been signed but there was no indication on the proposal of the Company name or the signee's position with the organization. The bid proposal was submitted in an envelope with Cimarron Construction's return address, so they were contacted and informed about the missing information. Jack McGee of Cimarron Construction confirmed that his company submitted the bid. He also did not realize that his bid submittal was incomplete. Deputy City Attorney Leubberke has also reviewed the bid proposal from Cimarron Construction and feels that the City cannot accept their submittal.

Because of the nonresponsive bid from the lower bidder, and because the bid from Eagle Construction is approximately \$40,000 higher than the other bid, staff is recommending that Council reject all the bids and authorize readvertising for bids.

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE CONTRACT FOR PIG'S LAKE LEVEE
REPAIR, AND AUTHORIZING READVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on September 21, 1994 at 11:00 a.m. for the bid for Pig's Lake Levee Repair, described in the specifications therefor approved by the City Council on August 17, 1994; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked, and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

WHEREAS, there was an informality in the submittal of the lowest bid from Cimarron Construction wherein that firm submitted an incomplete bid proposal, and because the bid from the second bidder was \$40,000 higher than the low bid, staff recommends that Council reject all the bids and authorize readvertising for bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lodi City Council that all bids received are hereby rejected for the award of contract for Pig's Lake Levee Repair, and staff is authorized to readvertise for bids.
