AGENDA TITLE: Purchase of Underground Primary Electrical Cable (\$65,109.88)

MEETING DATE: November 2, 1994

PREPARED BY: Electric Utility Director

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the bid for the purchase of 30,800 feet of #2/0, and 21,000 feet of #2, 15kV underground primary conductor to the low bidder offering firm pricing, Cablec Utility Cable Company, Huntington Beach, California, in the amount of \$65,109.88.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On October 5, 1994, the City Council approved specifications and authorized advertisement for bids for this cable. The following bids were received and opened on October 26:



(Because of the current volatility in the price of copper, the potential savings in awarding the bid based on prices subject to escalation is not enough to warrant the risk of having actual final cost exceed Cablec's firm prices).

Some of the developments where this cable is required are Sunwest Plaza, Johnson Ranch 3, Century Meadows 1 and 2, Towne Ranch 2 and 3, Lodi West 2, and the Big 5 Sporting Goods store. Cable installations are also scheduled for the Industrial Substation, and for the Washington Street/Poplar Street project.

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE BID FOR PURCHASE OF #2/0 AND #2, 15KV
UNDERGROUND PRIMARY CONDUCTOR
