AGENDA TITLE: Approve specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for eleven metal halide globe-style luminaires for the veterans' memorial mall (EUD)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for eleven 70-watt metal halide Holophane *Prismasphere*® globe-style luminaires for the veterans' memorial mall.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Plans and specifications for the memorial mall call for installation of eleven 70-watt metal halide Holophane *Prismasphere*® globe-style post-top luminaires.

These lights are similar in appearance to the twenty-five Holophane luminaires recommended for purchase elsewhere on tonight's agenda. However, the metal halide lamps have a superior color rendering index, meaning the metal halide lamps in the veterans' mall will emit a warmer, more natural light than the high pressure sodium lamps used for streetlighting applications.


