BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Lodi's Police Department recently produced a video titled "HIV/AIDS and Communicable Diseases Prevention in the Workplace" for City employees. The video was produced under the direction of Police Sergeant Ron Tobeck. Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations and Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations require employers to educate employees on the risks of bloodborne pathogens and means for preventing exposure to such highly communicable diseases as HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis B.

The video represents a modified training tool for not only City employees but also for any citizen who may be called upon to administer first aid to someone in need. It is hoped that this video will heighten the public's awareness of bloodborne pathogens and help reduce the number of incidents of exposure to these diseases.
