 CHAPTER 2.48

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
RECOMMENDED ACTION: Following reading by title, it would be appropriate for the City
 Council to adopt Ordinance No. 1504.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Ordinance No. 1504 entitled, "An Ordinance of the Lodi City
 Council Repealing in Its Entirety Ordinance No. 1473 Entitled, 'An
 Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Lodi Authorizing an
 Amendment to the Contract Between the City Council of the City of
 Lodi and the Board of Administration of the California Public
Employees' Retirement System', Thereby Amending Lodi Municipal Code Chapter 2.48" was
introduced at the December 19, 1990 City Council meeting.

At the December 19, 1990 City Council meeting, the City Council also adopted Resolution No.
90-195 - "A Resolution of Intention to Approve an Amendment to the Contract Between the
Board of Administration of the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) and the City
Council of the City of Lodi" to provide third level of 1959 Survivor Benefits for local
miscellaneous members and local safety members and one year final compensation for local
fire members only.

State of California Government Code Section 20460 requires a 20-day period between the
adoption of the Resolution of Intention and the final action.

This ordinance has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.

ORDINANCE NO. 1504

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY, ORDINANCE NO. 1473 ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI AUTHORIZING AN
AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI
AND THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
RETIREMENT SYSTEM", THEREBY AMENDING LODI MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.48

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Lodi Municipal Code Chapter 2.48 is hereby amended by
the repeal in its entirety of Ordinance 1473 as adopted on January 17,
1990.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict
herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi

thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
