MEETING DATE: February 6, 1991
AGENDA TITLE: Plans and Specifications and Advertisement for Bids for Ham Lane Improvements, Kettleman Lane to Vine Street

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the above project and authorize advertising for bids.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project will provide an asphalt overlay on Ham Lane between Kettleman Lane and Vine Street. This project will also do some minor widening on the north side of Kettleman Lane to provide two left turn lanes for the southbound traffic on Ham Lane.

Ham Lane will be completely closed during the paving operation. Staff estimates the actual paving will be done in two days.

This project will be using Federal (FAU) funds. In accordance with Federal regulations, the contract estimate is not public. The project estimate (which is the contract estimate plus engineering, inspection, and contingencies) is \$170,000. Award cannot be made until Caltrans reviews the bids and approves the award.
