AGENDA TITLE: Renew Agreement With San Joaquin County for Dial-A-Ride Services for Certain Unincorporated Areas

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a Resolution renewing the agreement between the City of Lodi and San Joaquin County for Dial-A-Ride services in the unincorporated areas of Woodbridge, the Arbor Mobile Home Park in Acampo, and the Freeway Mobile Home Park south of Lodi.

BACKGROUND: The City of Lodi has for some time been servicing the unincorporated areas of Woodbridge, the Arbor Mobile Home Park in Acampo, and the Freeway Mobile Home Park south of Lodi with Dial-A-Ride services, commencing with service to Arbor Mobile Home Park in October 1984. The County reimburses the City at the rate of \$4.66 per ticket to offset operational costs for the transit program. The City averages approximately 362 calls per month for services in the County contract areas.

The term of the agreement will be for a period of three years, terminating June 30, 1996, with the ticket reimbursement price subject to review for the second and third years of the agreement. Service hours have been extended in the agreement to reflect the new Sunday hours for Dial-A-Ride, and all references to City Cab Company have been deleted from the agreement.

FUNDING: San Joaquin County and Transportation Development Act Funds.


