AGENDA TITLE: Adopt Resolution Awarding Contract for Lower Sacramento Road Median Landscaping and Irrigation Project, Kettleman Lane to Harney Lane, to Odyssey Landscape of Stockton (\$186,100)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution awarding the contract for the above project to Odyssey Landscape, of Stockton, in the amount of \$186,100.40.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of furnishing and installing landscaping and irrigation materials and equipment for approximately 50,000 square feet of roadway median. The selection and layout of trees, shrub and groundcover materials is consistent with that installed on Lower Sacramento Road north of Kettleman Lane. A concrete median edging will be installed instead of the bricks used on the north, all as shown on the plans and specifications for the above project.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on July 6, 2005. The City received the following six bids for this project.

The project estimate of \$220,000 includes an allowance for construction contingencies, soil scientist services, inspection services, and construction services by the landscape architect.

FISCAL IMPACT: Future annual maintenance costs of approximately \$10,000 will be incorporated into adjacent development's landscape maintenance charges.
