RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt a resolution awarding the purchase of 20,000 feet of #1/0 15kV concentric-neutral, EPR-insulated underground cable from The Okonite Company of San Ramon, CA in the amount of \$46,440.25.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On January 17, 2007, the City Council approved specifications and authorized advertisement for bids for this conductor.

The following bids were received and opened on February 21, 2007:

Northwest Datacom & Power, Reno, NV	\$49,327.95
Prysmian Cables & Systems, Lexington, SC	\$50,204.40

The #1/0 15kV underground cable is a standard component of the City's electric power network. It will be used in new residential and commercial developments and in electrical distribution system upgrades. Some projects that are planned for the installation of this cable include the Auto Center Drive loop and line extension and the rebuilding of underground system around Geweke Toyota area. The estimated cable length for these projects is approximately 7,000 feet.

FISCAL IMPACT: Cost of this purchase is \$46,440.25

FUNDING AVAILABLE: Included in the Fiscal Year 2006-07 approved budget under Account No. 160651-7713.
