**AGENDA TITLE:** Adopt Resolution Awarding Contract for Lockeford Street and Sacramento Street Signal and Lighting Project to Pacific Excavation, of Elk Grove, (\$252,800) and Appropriating Additional Funds (\$62,000)

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** That the City Council adopt a resolution awarding the contract for the Lockeford Street and Sacramento Street Signal and Lighting Project to Pacific Excavation, of Elk Grove, in the amount of \$252,799 and appropriating additional funds as shown below.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** This project consists of installing a traffic signal, street lighting, wheelchair ramps, emergency and railroad preemption, and modifying signing and striping at the Sacramento Street and Lockeford Street intersection, and other incidental and related work all as shown on the plans and specifications for the project. Signalization for this intersection is a mitigation measure identified for the Lodi Station Parking Structure in the February 2001 Environmental Assessment.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on April 5, 2006. The City received the following four bids for this project on May 3, 2006.

 The requested appropriation includes contingency and the Union Pacific Railroad interconnection charges.


