**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the purchase of 210 High Pressure Sodium luminaires to the low bidder, Oeco Utility Supply Company of Vacaville. in the amount of \$12,224.24.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** On November 20. 1991, the City Council approved specifications and authorized advertisement for bids. Bids were opened on December 17, 1991, with the following results:

This purchase is part of the Electric Utility Department's ongoing program to replace mercury vapor streetlights with the more efficient high pressure sodium luminaires.

AND AUTHORIZING REAOVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

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WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on December 17, 1991 at 11:00 am. for the bid for the purchase of 210 high pressure sodium luminaires for the Electric Utility Department, described in the specifications therefor approved by the City Council on November 20, 1991; and
