AGENDA TITLE: Purchase of 12KV Bus Fittings for the Industrial Substation Project

MEETING DATE: February 19, 1992

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the bid for the purchase of approximately 1,300 connectors, fasteners, and supports for use in construction of the Industrial Substation's 12KV distribution structure to the low bidder, Sefcor, Inc. of Griffin, Georgia, in the amount of \$36,692.85.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On January 15, 1992. the City Council approved specifications and authorized advertisement for bids for electrical bus fittings. Bids were opened on February 6. 1992:

Sefcor. Inc.. Griffin, GA	\$36,692.85
Maydwell b Hartzell. Brisbane. CA	40,498.75*
PowerCom, Orinda. CA	42,987.54*

* (Maydwell b Hartzell and PowerCom did not bid all items).

The electrical bus fittings will be used in the construction of the 12kv distribution structure at the Industrial Substation. This structure, a major component of the system expansion being installed at the site, will provide additional electrical capacity, primarily for industrial and commercial customers in the eastern part of the City.






SUBJECT: 1248 South School Street
