RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt the attached resolution awarding the contract for disposal of PCB contaminated waste to the low bidder U.S. Pollution Control, Inc. (USPCI) of Houston, Texas, in the amount of \$23,041.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On March 18, 1992, the City Council approved specifications and authorized advertisement for bids. Bids were opened on April 2, 1992 with the following results.


The Electric Utility Department, in its multi-year program to eliminate PCB contaminated oil-filled equipment, has collected forty-eight transformers, twenty-seven 55-gal. drums of liquid and three 55-gal. drums of solid material contaminated with PCBs. This material must be disposed of in accordance with Federal and State guidelines by registered hazardous waste disposal firms.
