BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Staff was advised last week that the County of San Joaquin was contributing \$50,000 toward efforts of legislative advocacy of the completion of Auburn Dam. It was suggested that the City of Lodi join in this effort with a **token** contribution of \$1,000. Staff has since learned that the \$50,000 amount is being pledged by the San Joaquin Partnership at the request of the County. Since the City of Lodi is a contributor to the San Joaquin Partnership, as is the County, it is recommended that no additional City funding be pledged, and that this item be removed from the agenda.




