RECOMMENDED ACTION: The City Council authorize a 5% increase in water rates. The appropriate rates are included in the attached ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Water rates were last adjusted in March 1989.

The costs associated with providing water service in 1991-92 are \$116,490 more than budgeted for in 1990-91. The recommended increase will provide approximately \$120,000 additional revenue in 1991-92 fiscal year.

ORDINANCE NO. 1514

AN UNCODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
ADOPTING A REVISED SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES FOR WATER SERVICE
AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 1448

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 5471 and Lodi Municipal Code Section 13.08.010, the Lodi City Council is empowered to adopt or modify by uncodified ordinance, a schedule of rates for water service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on January 4, 1989 adopted rates as set forth in Ordinance 1448;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1448 is repealed in its entirety.

The schedule of water service for the City of Lodi shall be as follows:

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Government Code Section 36937(d), as a usual and current expense of the City, the rates set in this Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and shall be applied to all billings made for water-furnished on or after August 1, 1991.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect upon its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AMENDING LODI MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 13.04
BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION 13.04.125
ENTITLED "WAIVER OF CERTAIN CHARGES"

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Lodi Municipal Code Chapter 13.04 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Section 13.04.125 entitled "Waiver of certain charges", to read in full as follows:

13.04.125 Waiver of certain charges.

"A. The Finance Director shall be authorized, within his discretion, to cancel all closed accounts with a balance due the City of five dollars or less.

"B. Refunds on closed accounts of five dollars or less will not be made unless a specific request is received by the Finance Director from the party to whom a refund is to be made."

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and

published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
