

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City authorize the City Manager and the City Clerk to execute an agreement with the Woodbridge Irrigation District for the installation of granular activated carbon filter system at Well 16, 1426 West Century Boulevard.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Woodbridge Irrigation District (WID) is allowing the City to use a portion of its right-of-way to install a state required granular activated carbon filter system at Well 16. This agreement gives us permission to install the filter system and enter the WID right-of-way for inspection and maintenance purposes. This WID agreement will expire in ten years. Staff is expecting Well 16 to be free of dibromochloropropane (DBCP) by that time. If additional filtering is required, a new agreement will be negotiated

This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney.



FURTHER RESOLVED, the Council hereby authorizes the City Manager and City Clerk to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City.


