RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the contract for the above project to Scrimsher and Mineni Construction in the amount of \$20,137.00.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project is the construction of a 240 square foot concrete block storage building for pool equipment and supplies. The building will be located immediately north of the mechanical equipment on the east side of the new Mel Enze pool.

Also included is some additional concrete flatwork for storing the pool cover reels.

Plans and specifications were approved by the City Council on January 3, 1990.
