**APPROVED FOR LOWER**  
SACRAMENTO ROAD IMPROVEMENTS,  
900 FEET SOUTH OF LODI AVENUE  
TO 400 FEET NORTH OF  
TEJON STREET

**CC-12.1(c)**

The City Council was requested to approve the plans and specifications for Lower Sacramento Road Improvements, 900 feet south of Lodi Avenue to 400 feet north of Tejon Street.

This project consists of pavement widening and restriping along Lower Sacramento Road to provide left turn pockets at the major intersections and construction of traffic signals and street improvements at the intersection of Lower Sacramento Road and Elm Street.

The total project cost **may** exceed available street funds, The specifications will identify **some** portions of the work that may be deleted to reduce cost, A **recommendation** on appropriations and alternatives will be made at the time of the award.

Addressing the City Council regarding the project were Walter and Janet **Pruss**, 2421 Diablo Drive, Lodi. Their remarks included the suggestion that the approach to the bridge in the subject area be level.

Following discussion, on motion of Mayor Pro Tempore Hinchman, Olson second, the City Council approved the plans and specifications and authorized advertising for bids - Lower Sacramento Road Improvements, 900 feet south of Lodi Avenue to 400 feet north of Tejon Street project.
