**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Adopt resolution amending Resolution No. 2010-69 (Granting Designated Period for Two Years Additional Service Credit) to exclude the classification of Park Maintenance Worker II.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The CalPERS Two Year Additional Service Credit program, as established under California Government Code Section 20903, allows the City (as part of a budget reduction process) to offer a retirement incentive of two years service credit to eligible employees. The current PERS contract allows the City, with Council approval, to offer the program to Miscellaneous and Fire (sworn) employees.

At its May 19, 2010 meeting, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2010-69, which offered two years additional service credit to two classifications: Fire Captain and Park Maintenance Worker II. Based on a review of budget and staffing needs for the Parks and Recreation Department, staff is recommending Council amend Resolution No. 2010-69 and exclude the classification of Park Maintenance Worker II.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** There is no fiscal impact from excluding the Park Maintenance Worker II classification from the Two Year Additional Service Credit program.
