SUBJECT: 1990-91 APPROPRIATIONS SPENDING LIMIT

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the Lodi City Council set *the* 1990-91 Appropriations Spending Limit at \$30,875,992.

BACKGROUND HISTORY: Article XIIIB of the California State Constitution specifies that an annual Appropriations Spending Limit shall be established.


The Spending Limit shall be adjusted each year by the changes in population (+2.26%) and the lesser of the Consumer Price Index or the California Per Capita Personal Income (+4.21%).

The 1989-90 Limit of \$28,972,499, increased by population and California Per Capita personal Income, yields a 1990-91 Spending Limit of \$30,875,992.

$$(1.0226) (1.0421) = 1.0657$$
$$(1.0657) (\$28,972,499) = \$30,875,992$$

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby adopt the following Appropriations Spending Limit for 1990-91 in compliance with Proposition 4, now Article XIII B of the California State Constitution:

Increased by allowable accumulated
growth and California Per Capita
Income of 4.21%

Therefore, the Appropriations
Spending Limit for 1990-91 \$30,875,992


