AGENDA TITLE: Adopt Resolution Awarding the Purchase of 100,000 Feet of Insulated Underground Cable to The Okonite Company of San Ramon (\$237,183.75)

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Adopt a resolution awarding the purchase of 100,000 feet of insulated underground cable to The Okonite Company of San Ramon (\$237,183.75).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On March 2, 2011, the City Council approved specifications and authorized the advertisement for bids to procure 100,000 feet of #1/0 AWG, 15 kV, ethylene-propylene rubber-insulated with concentric neutral, underground cable. It will be used for new developments and existing electrical distribution system upgrades and replacements including the replacement of old underground cables in Grids 56 and 57.


The Electric Utility Department (EUD) advertised bid documents on June 6, 2011. Six medium voltage cable manufacturers and suppliers requested bid documents. On June 22, 2011, bids were opened with the following results:

Marmon Utility LLC, Milford, NH	\$280,659.17
General Cable Industries, Highland Height, KT	\$260,237.75
HD Supply Utilities, Benicia, CA	\$262,087.50
Prysmian Cables and Systems USA, Lexington, SC	\$258,155.10
One Source Distribution, Oakland, CA	\$265,350.00
The Okonite Company, San Ramon, CA	\$237,183.75

Staff reviewed the proposals and deemed The Okonite Company's bid the lowest and compliant with the approved specifications. Okonite has supplied EUD's 15 kV EPR underground cables since 2003. The last procurement from Okonite was in April 2007.


FISCAL IMPACT: Procurement cost is \$237,183.75.

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 100,000 FEET OF
#1/0 AWG, 15 KV, ETHYLENE PROPYLENE RUBBER
INSULATED UNDERGROUND CONDUCTOR FROM THE
OKONITE COMPANY, OF SAN RAMON, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on June 22, 2011 at 11:00 a.m., for the purchase of 100,000 feet of #1/0 AWG, 15 kV, ethylene propylene rubber insulated underground cable, described in the specifications therefore, approved by the City Council on March 2, 2011; and
