
To: The State of California Attorney General, Department of
General Services, County and City Officials:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby gives
notice that in Application No. 90-07-067, filed July 26,
1990, with the California Public Utilities Commission, it
has requested authority to increase its gas rates.

The requested rate adjustment would increase gas
revenues overall by approximately \$5.2 million in 1991, and
an additional \$2.0 million in 1992. The proposed amounts
would increase gas rates by less than one percent. The
increase is needed to implement an expanded Natural Gas
Vehicle Program.
