SUBJECT: APPROVE APPLICATION FOR THE THIRD YEAR OF FUNDING FOR THE COMMUNITY CRIME RESISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT THROUGH THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING

FUNDING SOURCE: Contingent Fund

The Lodi Police Department is requesting permission to apply for funding from the Office of Criminal Justice Planning under their Community Crime Resistance Program.

Lodi Police Department has been funded for two years under the Crime Resistance Program, beginning in July of 1986. The program has enabled our department to hire two Community Service Officers for our Crime Prevention Unit. They have developed Neighborhood Watch programs throughout the City and worked extensively in the schools especially with student safety patrol.

Continued funding will allow us to expand our crime prevention function with new areas targeted for Neighborhood Watch and activities specifically for seniors.

If successful, the funds granted will total \$50,000. A ten percent cash match is required by the City of Lodi.

Captain Larry Hansen will be present to answer questions.

RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE FILING WITH THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING
OF AN APPLICATION FOR A COMMUNITY CRIME RESISTANCE GRANT - PHASE III

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi desires to continue a certain project designated as the Community Crime Resistance Program which was funded in part from the 1985 statutes for the California Community Crime Resistance Program, and/or federal funds as authorized under the Justice Assistance Act of 1984, Public Law 98-473, administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (hereafter referred to as OCJP).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Lodi are hereby authorized, on its behalf to submit the attached application to OCJP for the third year of funding for the Community Crime Resistance Program Grant through the office of Criminal Justice Planning, and are authorized to execute the application on behalf of the City of Lodi Police Department.

BE IT RESOLVED that the applicant agrees to provide all matching funds required for Phase III of said project under the Community Crime Resistance Program and the rules and regulations of OCJP and that cash will be appropriated as required thereby.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
