 GENERAL SERVICES BARGAINING UNIT EMPLOYEES



BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City received a petition signed by 42 persons requesting decertification of IBEW Local 1245 as the majority representative of the General Services Unit. In accordance with provisions of Resolution 3344, a secret ballot election was held on April 26, 1988. The result of the election was 43 to 17 in favor of withdrawing certification.

The same petition asked that the San Joaquin County Employees Association be named the majority representative of the General Services Unit. In as much as those signing the petition and the overwhelming vote in favor of decertification, formal recognition to the San Joaquin County Employees Association as the majority representative for the General Services Unit should be granted.

As a point of information, this unit consists of clerical workers, engineers, meter readers, and other white collar occupations.
