RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the contract for the above project to Dura Fence, Sacramento in the amount of \$6,598.00.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of furnishing and installing approximately 360 linear feet of 6' high chain link fence and 7 gates. This fencing will enclose the quarter-block section bounded by Main Street, Locust Street, and the alley south. This area was formerly used by the Parks and Recreation Department as a storage area and was left without fencing due to the construction of the new water tower and modification of Well #4.

The plans and specifications for this project were approved on May 3, 1989. The City has received the following 10 bids for this project.


