The City Council approved re-advertising the subject project and set a new bid opening date of July 13, 1988.

The City Council was apprised that this project includes the installation of City furnished double-walled tanks. The tanks are as follows:

<u>Public Safety Building</u>	<u>Municipal Service Center</u>
Unleaded - 10,000 gallon	Regular - 2,000 gallon
Diesel - 2,000 gallon	Unleaded - 10,000 gallon
	Diesel - 5,000 gallon
	Waste Oil - 2,000 gallon

A small portion (approximately \$60,000) of this expenditure is State reimbursable.

Plans and specifications for this project were approved on ~~May~~ 18, 1988. Bid: were to be opened on June 8, 1988; however, none were received. Six contractors who had plans and specifications were contacted. Two were too busy to bid and four were having various problems with bonding. Apparently most of this type of work is done for the private sector where bonds are not required. Based on these conversations, Staff felt the City would receive some bids if we rebid the project.
