ORDINANCE NO. 1437

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SPECIFIC PLAN OF LOWER SACRAMENTO ROAD  
BETWEEN KETTLEMAN LANE AND LODI AVENUE, LODI

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Authority - Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 65450) of Title 7 of the Government Code of the State of California, and pursuant to that certain General Plan, as amended, for the City of Lodi, adopted by the City Council, Resolution No. 1885, on October 5, 1955, the Specific Plan for Lower Sacramento Road between Kettleman Lane and Lodi Avenue, Lodi, as adopted by Resolution No. 3665, on August 16, 1972, is hereby ratified and amended.


Section 2. Purpose - It is hereby declared that this Specific Plan is adopted to provide for and protect the health, safety, and convenience and welfare of the citizens of the City of Lodi.

Section 3. The City Council may, by motion action, from time to time vary the fencing and sidewalk details as displayed on Drawing 721370 of the City of Lodi.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Lodi, and shall be in force and take effect 30 days from and after its passage and approval.


