Dear Mr. Barber:

Your recommendation that I become one of the first Councilmembers of the San Joaquin County Arts Council was one of the finest things that have been done for me.

Through this organization's meetings, I have been able to meet representatives of the arts throughout the county. The work of this group has been very rewarding for all of us. We know that increased awareness of the Council and the Supervisors' aims for the Council will make its work much more effective.

This letter is for the purpose of tendering my resignation. There is no other reason that could possibly have caused this to happen, except this one: I shall be entering the Peace Corps on March 24, 1984. On January 13, we leave Los Angeles for training in Ponape and Truk or Palau. At the end of this training, my two-year service with the Corps will begin. This new adventure in Micronesia is very exciting to me and, I hope, very rewarding to the residents of the islands and myself. I shall be aiding in the setting up of co-operatives in Truk or Palau and helping in furthering the self-sufficient goal of the people.

This resignation will be effective upon your receiving this letter. Members of the Council have begun to look for a replacement for this seat, and I know that there are many qualified persons in District 4 who can do this work.

Thank you, again, for your nomination and for my being able to associate with such vital, stimulating and forward-looking individuals.
