
**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the above mentioned project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received Tuesday, January 19, 1982.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The reconstruction of Sacramento Street Industrial Waste Lift Station was approved in the 80-81 Capital Improvement Budget and rebudgeted in the 81-82 budget.

In general, the work consists of furnishing and delivering two (2) submersible non-clog sewage pumps.

**NOTE:** Due to long delivery time for pumps and motors, the bid will be opened January 19, 1982 and sent to Council for awarding January 20, 1982.

The engineer's contract estimate is \$20,000. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$60,000.
