IN APPLICATION NO. 60153

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY hereby gives notice that in Application No. 60153, filed with the California Public Utilities Commission on December 23, 1980, it has requested authorization, among other things, to increase its rates and charges for electric and gas service.

The proposed rates will increase PGandE's electric revenues about 37.1% or \$1.138 billion annually, and its gas revenues about 9.8% or \$316.2 million annually, on a year 1982 basis. Effective January 1, 1983, PGandE is requesting that its customers' electric and gas rates be further increased to produce revenues of \$178.6 million and \$127.7 million, respectively. These increases are necessary to meet the increasing costs of operations and to enable PGandE to maintain the financial health necessary to permit it to attract the capital needed to construct the facilities required to provide electric and gas service to its customers.

The state, the counties, the municipal corporations, and other parties interested in the above-mentioned filing will be furnished a copy of Application No. 60153, with related exhibits, upon written request made to PGandE, 77 Beale Street, San Francisco, California 94102, Attention: Mr. Robert Ohlbach, Associate General Counsel.

This notice is given in accordance with Rule 24 of the revised Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission.
