Council was reminded that it had previously approved City participation (\$2,000) in the rehabilitation of the Southern Pacific tracks in Lockeford Street as part of the City's 1986 Capital Improvement Program. This amount covers the additional work required of Southern Pacific to raise their track in order to provide the City with the amount of street crossfall that the City desires.

Council adopted Resolution No. 86-07 approving agreement regarding City's participation in the rehabilitation of the Southern Pacific railroad tracks on Lockeford Street, Pleasant Avenue to Sacramento Street and authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the subject document on behalf of the City.

RECITALS:

The parties hereto desire to set forth by this instrument
their agreements with respect to the rehabilitation of Lockford
Street where same crosses tracks and property of Railroad, at
or near Lodi, in the County of San Joaquin, State of
California.

AGREEMENT:

1. Railroad shall provide the necessary labor, tools and
equipment and shall perform the following work:

- (a) remove existing crossing surface;
- (b) prepare its track, including relay of rail and
ties;
- (c) install subgrade stabilization; and
- (d) raise the track to provide proper drainage.

2. City shall contribute to Railroad the sum of twenty-nine
thousand dollars (\$29,000) as its share of the cost to Railroad in
performing the work specified in Section 1 above.

3. City, at its expense, will provide all the required
barricades and signs to accomplish the work specified above.

4. The work to be performed by Railroad hereunder shall be
commenced as soon as labor and materials are available, following
execution of this instrument, and shall be completed within one (1)
year thereafter.

5. The print of Railroad's Drawing B-17936 dated January 9,
1984, is attached and hereby made a part hereof.

6. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of Railroad and the assigns of City.







SUBJECT: SPRR Rehabilitation
Lockeford Street - Pleasant to Sacramento

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council, by Resolution, approve the attached agreement regarding City participation in the rehabilitation of the S.P. railroad tracks on Lockeford Street.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Council has previously approved City participation (\$29,000) in the rehabilitation of the S.P. tracks in Lockeford Street as part of the City's 1986 CIP. This amount covers the additional work required of SP to raise their track in order to provide the City with the amount of street crossfall that we desire.

S.P. Co. has prepared the attached agreement covering the participation which needs to be approved by the City Council. The tracks will be reconstructed in the existing location as part of the City's Lockeford Street rehabilitation project.
