	As Specified	As Bid
Outriggers	Remove and repack outrigger cylinders. Install all new pins, hoses and fittings. All replaced parts to be approved standard high pressure hydraulic type.	
Inner Boom	Inspect inner boom for possible repairs or replacement. Advise City of Lodi of recommendation and estimated cost.	
Winch Cable	Replace wire rope, 100 ft., 3/8" diameter, non-spin with 6" eye splice in on end.	
Pivot Pins	Replace all pivot pins on derrick. Old pins to be returned to City of Lodi.	
Hydraulic Drive	Check hydraulic drive system completely; install all new hoses and fittings with approved high pressure hydraulic type. Replaced parts to be returned to City of Lodi.	

	As Specified	As Bid
Rear Outriggers	Install foldout outriggers at rear with control at pedestal, Model 1A-192 or equal. Supply shop drawing or typical catalog picture as reference in regards to bed position, etc. Install complete new set of control knobs at control station. Old knobs to be returned to City of Lodi.	
Certification	Certify derrick assembly to meet OSHA, Industrial Relations, Title 8, as required for this model and capacity derrick. A decal to be affixed by the manufacturer's plate, indicating date of certifications, etc.	
Miscellaneous Work	Tear down operations may produce additional repairs and replacement of items and labor. It is the bidder's responsibility to notify the City of Lodi of each and all situations for a time and material cost factor.	
Body	Boom Support: Reinforce as required for load capacity with boom retracted and fully extended. Prime and spot paint as required.	
Derrick	Remove and rebuild extension cylinder, remove boom and D ring to boom for two part winch line.	

It is the intent of these specifications to provide a safe, certified and economically operating derrick truck for crew operations in the Water/Sewer Division of the City of Lodi.
