SCHEDULE EP

ENERGY PURCHASE

APPLICABILITY:

Energy purchase schedule EP is applicable to qualifying customer-owned alternating current generating facilities of 100 kw capacity or less, operating in parallel with the City's electric system.

RATE:

Energy Price	<u>Per Meter</u> <u>Per Month</u>
All purchased kwhr, per kwhr	\$0.0159

Fuel Cost Adjustment:

An amount equal to the product of the purchased kilowatt hours (per meter per month), times an adjustment amount per kilowatt hour, will be added to the price computed using the above rate. The adjustment amount per kilowatt hour will be equal to the P.G.&E. wholesale unit fuel cost adjustment for the month during which the energy is delivered.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

A contract is required for all energy purchased under this schedule.

ORDINANCE NO. 1220

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW ELECTRIC RATE
SCHEDULE FOR THE PURCHASE OF ENERGY FROM
CUSTOMERS WITH SMALL QUALIFYING ELECTRIC
GENERATING FACILITIES

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established rate schedule EP for the purchase of energy from customers with small qualifying electric generating facilities at the rates hereinafter set forth:

SCHEDULE EP

ENERGY PURCHASE

APPLICABILITY:

Energy purchase schedule EP is applicable to qualifying customer-owned alternating current generating facilities of 100 kw capacity or less, operating in parallel with the City's electric system.

RATE:

Energy Price	<u>Per Meter Per Month</u>
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All purchased kwhr, per kwhr . . . \$0.0159

Fuel Cost Adjustment:

An amount equal to the product of the purchased kilowatt hours (per meter per month), times an adjustment amount per kilowatt hour, will be added to the price computed using the above rate. The adjustment amount per kilowatt hour will be equal to the P.G.&E. wholesale unit fuel cost adjustment for the month during which the energy is delivered.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

A contract is required for all energy purchased under this schedule.

Section 2. Effective Date. The Ordinance is being published one time in the "Lodi Life and Times", a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect March 20, 1981.

Section 3. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.
