A petition bearing approximately 400 signatures reading as follows was presented by Mr. James John, 1123 Alpine Drive, Lodi:

"We, the undersigned, hereby petition the City Council of the City of Lodi to establish, operate and maintain a public transportation system to serve the needs of the citizens of Lodi, California. We further request that this system be placed in operation as expediently as possible and that any available state, local or federal funds be used to the extent that they can be authorized. Time is of the essence and we want you, as our elected officials, to take action to implement the intent of this petition without further delay.

Mr. John was apprised that the subject of transportation would be discussed later on the Agenda; and invited his comments at that time.
